



Configuring NetSweeper Filtering on CachePilot

Overview of operation and configuration

Most of the NetSweeper ongoing administrator facilities are available by accessing the web based administration interface provided by the NetSweeper organization. This allows control of users and categories that can be viewed by pupils.

As regards CachePilot operating with NetSweeper, CachePilot administrator configuration is limited to the initial installation tasks.

The administrator is required to manually enter DNS entries for the NetSweeper server(s). A minimum of one, and a maximum of three server DNS entries must be added.

The NetSweeper operation is enabled/disabled by a tick-box which is displayed on the CachePilot `Web Sites - Site lists - Edit - global forbidden sites' page (examples below).

Customised versions of CachePilot Software

CachePilot software can be factory customized for specific applications/users. Those customers that ordered units pre-configured for use with NetSweeper URL filtering - will as default - have access to the appropriate configuration screens. Those that have standard CachePilot software builds and wish to upgrade their units in the field to interact with NetSweeper filtering need to apply Equinet's upgrade called "0000667.nub". Details of how to apply "nub" upgrades are available from Equinet.

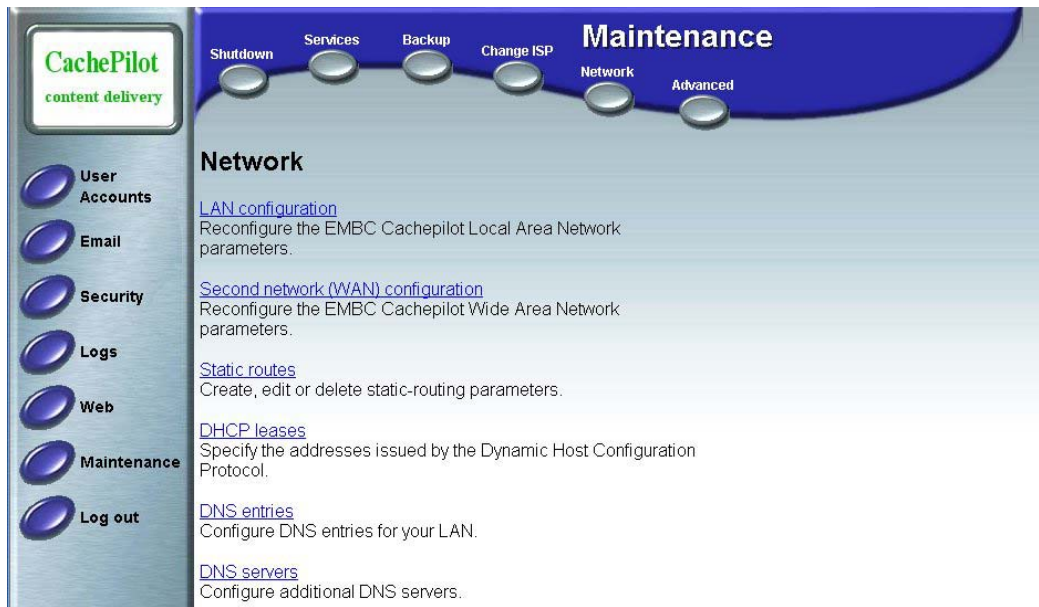


Configuring NetSweeper Filtering on CachePilot

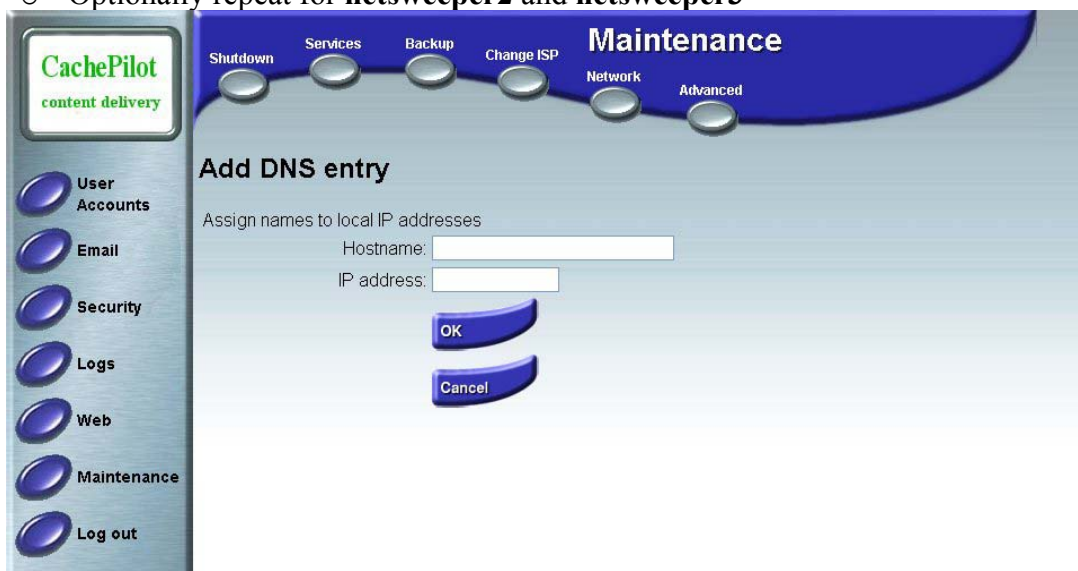
Detailed Notes on Configuration of CachePilot for NetSweeper operation

Step 1 : Add DNS entries for NetSweeper server(s)

- Click on side bar button **Maintenance**
- Click on the top bar button **Network**
- Click on mid page Link **DNS Entries**



- Click on **Add**
- Enter name **netsweeper1** and IP Address
- Optionally repeat for **netsweeper2** and **netsweeper3**





Configuring NetSweeper Filtering on CachePilot

Step 2 : Enable NetSweeper Tick Box

- Logon to CachePilot as ADMIN
- Click on side bar button **Web**
- Click on mid page Link **Site Lists**



- Select the Site List **Global Forbidden Sites**, then click on **Edit** button
- Ensure the Tick Box for NetSweeper is enabled at the bottom of the screen
