



## Multi Level Administration

### Setting up multiple administration accounts with differing access levels

This facility gives the 'Admin' Administrator the ability to set additional Administrators the same level, or as a 'Site Administrator' or as a 'Cache Administrator'. The procedure is similar in all cases - first set up a new user with appropriate password and then promote the user to the required level via the 'Site Admin' command.

- To access the option to add Administration permissions to an account. You will need to log into your unit using an account that has the full Admin rights.
- Select the **User Accounts** option from the left hand titles and **Users** option from the top menu and **add** a new user. The Equinet convention is to use the usernames 'cacheadmin' and 'siteadmin' although any name can be used. The user group selected for this user has no affect upon access to the menu screens. See example below of creating a user call 'CacheAdmin'
